4. PROCEDURE FOR BLUE-GREEN ALGAE HEALTH ADVISORY NOTICES, PRESENTATION BY THE MARTIN COUNTY DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH

Mr. Nick Clifton, Health Officer/Administrator of the Florida Department of Health, briefly presented on the Martin County Department of Health tests for blue-green algae and the protocol for advisory notices. He stated that if citizens see signs of algae, they are encouraged to take a photo and send it in to floridadep.gov/AlgalBloom.

City Manager Michael Mortell presented the update, and provided a map of the City boundary demonstrating future land use, a brief historical timeline, explanation of the Comprehensive Plan, census statistics, development approvals, and growth rate.

After meeting with staff, it's been determined that those who have been notified will enter into a revocable permit, and no future expansions will be done without City permission and no citations or code enforcement hearings will result. An acknowledgment will be shared by property owners to not store personal property in the public right-of-way and to acknowledge that these parking spaces are not considered private property. Those that received a letter will receive a follow-up letter pertaining to the revocable permit.
