1. BUDGET PRESENTATION

Michael Mortell, City Manager, provided a brief review of Budget Workshop #1 and tax bills that went out to City residents. The budget presented at this meeting does not exceed 4.75 Mills per the consensus of the Commission.

Louis “Joly” Boglioli, Finance Director, presented the status update, noting the prepared budget at 4.75 Mills. Joly referenced the TRIM notice, announced the dates of the upcoming Special Commission Meeting for the Tentative Millage and Tentative Budget on September 8th at 5:15 PM.

City Manager Mortell initiated the board discussion. Discussions included union contracts, tax bills, services, public safety and calculations referring to the exact millage proposed being 4.8733.

1. Helen McBride - Stuart; Commented that a reduced budget will hurt services and people in the community.
2. Mark Brechbill - Stuart; Commented positively on the approach to temporary cost cuts to better identify permanent needs in the future.
