CONSENT CALENDAR: Those matters included under the Consent Calendar are self-explanatory, non-controversial, and are not expected to require review or discussion. All items will be enacted by one motion. If discussion on an item is desired by any City Commissioner that item may be removed by a City Commissioner from the Consent Calendar and considered separately. If an item is quasi-judicial it may be removed by a Commissioner or any member of the public from the Consent Calendar and considered separately.

QUASI-JUDICIAL HEARINGS: Some of the matters on the Agenda may be "quasi-judicial" in nature. City Commissioners will disclose all ex-parte communications, and may be subject to voir dire by any interested party regarding those communications. All witnesses testifying will be "sworn" prior to their testimony. However, the public is permitted to comment without being sworn. Unsworn testimony will be given appropriate weight and credibility by the City Commission.

WHEREAS, the City Commission of the City of Stuart, Florida, of Martin County, Florida, on September 26th, 2022, adopted Fiscal Year Final Millage Rates following a public hearing as required by Florida Statute §200.065;

WHEREAS, City Commission of the City of Stuart, Florida, of Martin County, Florida, held a public hearing as required by Florida Statute §200.065; and

WHEREAS, the gross taxable value for operating purposes not exempt from taxation within Martin County has been certified by the County Property Appraiser to the City of Stuart, Florida, as \$ 2,741,265,012;

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE

SECTION 1: The FY 2023 operating millage rate is 5.0000 mills, which is greater than the rolled-back rate of 4.6513 mills by 7.5%.

SECTION 2: The voted debt service millage is 0.1700 mills.

WHEREAS, the City of Stuart, Florida, of Martin County, Florida, on September 26th, 2022, held a public hearing as required by Florida Statute §200.065; and

WHEREAS, the City of Stuart, Florida, of Martin County, Florida, set forth the appropriations and revenue estimate for the Budget for Fiscal Year 2023 as follows:

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE
CITY OF STUART, FLORIDA** that:

SECTION 1: The City of Stuart, Florida hereby adopts the budget, attached hereto, for the fiscal year beginning October 1, 2022 and ending September 30, 2023, as follows:

(a) There is hereby appropriated from the GENERAL FUND of the City of Stuart for the above described fiscal year, the total sum of Thirty-Eight Million, Nine Hundred Ninety-Six Thousand, Five Hundred Ninety-Six (\$38,996,596) Dollars to provide for the annual budget of the General Fund.

(b) There is hereby appropriated from the LANDFILL PROPERTY FUND of the City of Stuart for the above described fiscal year the total sum of Forty Thousand, Eight Hundred Sixty-Seven (\$40,867) Dollars to provide for the annual budget of the Landfill Closure Trust Fund.

(c) There is hereby appropriated from the COMMUNITY REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY of the City of Stuart for the above described fiscal year the total sum of Six Million, Eighty-Seven

Thousand, Eighty-Three (\$6,087,083) Dollars to provide for the annual budget of the Community Redevelopment Agency Fund.

(d) There is hereby appropriated from the LEASED PROPERTY FUND of the City of Stuart for the above described fiscal year the total sum of One Million, Five Hundred Forty-Eight Thousand, Nine Hundred Fifty-Four (\$1,548,954) Dollars to provide for the annual budget of The Property Management Fund.

(e) There is hereby appropriated from the POLICE SPECIAL REVENUES FUND of the City of Stuart for the above described fiscal year the total sum of Fifty-Four Thousand Nine Hundred (\$54,900) Dollars to provide for the annual budget of the Police Special Revenues Fund.

(f) There is hereby appropriated from the WATER AND SEWER FUND of the City of Stuart for the above described fiscal year the total sum of Thirty Million, Two Hundred Thirty-Four Thousand, Two Hundred Thirty-Two (\$30,234,232) Dollars to provide for the annual budget of the Water and Sewer Fund.

(g) There is hereby appropriated from the SANITATION FUND of the City of Stuart for the above described fiscal year the total sum of Six Million, One Hundred Seventy-Seven Thousand, Two Hundred Twenty-Eight (\$6,177,228) Dollars to provide for the annual budget of the Sanitation Fund.

(h) There is hereby appropriated from the STORMWATER FUND of the City of Stuart for the above described fiscal year the total sum of Two Million, Nine Hundred Eighty-Three Thousand, Seven Hundred Thirty-Eight (\$2,983,738) Dollars to provide for the annual budget of the Stormwater Fund.

SECTION 2: This Resolution shall be effective immediately upon adoption.
